RLC CONFLICT MATERIAL POLICY STATEMENT

In 2012 the Security and Exchange Commission adopted rules, signed into law by President B.H. Obama, to implement the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010. As part of these new regulations, companies are required to understand the origin of the derivates of four minerals that are sourced from the Democratic Republic of Congo, or adjoining countries, from mines controlled by non-governmental military groups. Conflict materials are described as Gold (Au), Tantalum (Ta), Tungsten (W) and Tin (Sn), also known as 3TG.

RLC Electronic Systems certifies that, to the best of its knowledge based on reasonable inquiries with its suppliers, any conflict materials contained in product supplied by RLC Electronic Systems do not originate from DRC or adjoining countries, were derived from recycled or scrap sources, or were not necessary for the production or functionality of the product.
